

DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

We believe the Bible to be the only inspired, infallible, inerrant and authoritative Word of God.

We believe that there is one God, creator of heaven and earth, eternally existent in three distinct persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

We believe in the deity and humanity of Jesus Christ, that He was born of a virgin, that we are redeemed by His atoning death through His shed blood, that He bodily resurrected and ascended into Heaven, and that He will come again in power and great glory to judge the living and the dead.

We believe in the value and dignity of all people: created in God's image, but alienated from God and each other because of our sin and guilt, and justly subject to God's wrath.

We believe that regeneration by the Holy Spirit by grace through faith is essential for the salvation of lost and sinful people.

We believe in the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting solely through repentance and faith in Jesus Christ.

We believe that the Holy Spirit unites all believers in the Lord Jesus Christ and that together they form one body, the church.

Please be especially sensitive to issues of doctrinal disagreement. Members of the staff have liberty in areas that our doctrinal statement has not addressed. However, that liberty may not be used to divide other members of the staff. Please focus on areas of spiritual agreement, not on areas of disagreement.
