

Overcomers Application and Admission

Thank you for your interest in Overcomers. To gain admission to the program, each applicant must complete an application (written or electronic) and an intake interview by telephone or in person. If the applicant is in the Greenville area, we encourage him to call and arrange to come by for a interview, tour and application. All admissions are scheduled by staff. If you are calling for someone in a detention center, they are required to complete the application and telephone interview and must have a definite release date in order to be considered. In order to be accepted, applicants must pass an alcohol breathalyzer and drug screen on arrival to be accepted. We do not provide drug or alcohol detoxification. If an applicant is taking medications, they must be listed on the application, discussed with OC staff at time of interview, and approved prior to entry. We cannot allow any potentially addictive medications or sleep medications on the Overcomers campus. All mental health medications must be prescribed by a Psychiatrist and will need to be supervised by a mental health professional while in the program. You are required to have a thirty-day supply of medications on arrival. Additionally, the Overcomer Center is tobacco free; do not bring any tobacco products at time of admission. You will also be subject to random nicotine screens while in the program.

Please refer to the “what to bring list” on the website. Keep in mind that this is the maximum number of items to bring. If you have questions on what to bring, discuss this with staff prior to admission. Please do not bring any type of electronic devices such as cell phones, CD players or video games as they are not permitted and we have no way to store them.

An \$85.00 program materials fee, and a return bus ticket or funds for a ticket are required upon entry. If you cannot afford the fee, please discuss this with the counselor at time of application. Our goal is that no one be excluded from our program due to finances. We do encourage families to donate to Miracle Hill if they can afford to do so to help offset the program cost.

Finally, Overcomers is a 28-week Christian recovery program for men with life controlling issues such as chemical addictions. We are not a hospital or medical facility. Each resident will have a task assignment and must be able to participate fully in the program.
